For 2024 our Quokkas class have successfully embedded sustainable practices throughout the curriculum. The "Recycled Mini Mart," proved to be an ongoing interest for the children as they had the opportunity to "shop," with their peers and educators. Real life play scenarios are important for young children as it supports them to act out theories, confirm their understanding of the world around them all while strengthening social, emotional, physical and cognitive skills.

The use of cardboard boxes was also evident through sensory cubbies, combined with hanging ribbon. Opportunities for children to engage with cause and effect is important as they learn to problem solve, hypothesis and test theories. This also fosters opportunities for children to build relationships and negotiate play spaces.
